Clements Worldwide Announces the Global Launch of its Eighth Annual *Expat Youth Scholarship Contest*

Total scholarship contributions since 2009 will reach the \$80,000 mark this year.

Their parents could be diplomats or in the military or any number of the growing number of people who live and work outside of their home country.
